DESCRIPTION

On the vehicles affected by this bulletin, follow the procedure to correctly connect the connector over the pump.

PROCEDURE



Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop the engine. In the battery box, set the battery cut-off switch to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

Lockout & Tag out (LOTO) must be performed during set-up, maintenance or repair activities. Refer to your local procedure for detailed information regarding the control of hazardous energy.



Engine door Compartment

 Depressurized the cooling system located at the rear of the vehicle (driver side). Open the engine door and then turn the valve (counterclockwise). Wait 30 seconds and after turning it at the first position.




Condenser compartment (Big & Small A/C)




2- Pinch both hoses with vise-grip. The vise-grip should be covered with rubber or use specific tools to avoid damaging the hose.

- 3- Put absorbent towels under the hoses and in the compartment.
- 4- Loosen both connections. Be careful coolant can come out.



8- Put the clamp hose CT Caillau 12-22 at a distance of 3mm (1/8") to 10mm (3/8"), from the edge of the casing (see picture).



- 9- Tighten the hose clamp to 30lbs/in.
- 10- Make sure that the tab of the hose clamp does not interfere with a tube. Install the cable tie removed before.
- 11- Remove the vise-grip
- 12- Clean the compartment
