DESCRIPTION

Perform the following procedure to remove the dashboard covers. Reinstallation is similar to removal but in reverse order.

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SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Eye protection should always be worn when working in a shop.
- Rules for Personal Protection Equipment should always be respected. Wear your PPE including but not limited to the following:






Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop the engine. Prior to working on the vehicle, set the ignition switch to the OFF position and trip the main circuit breakers equipped with a trip button. On Commuter type vehicles, set the battery master switch (master cut-out) to the OFF position.

Lockout & Tag out (LOTO) must be performed during set-up, maintenance or repair activities. Refer to your local procedure for detailed information regarding the control of hazardous energy.


PART 1 - INSTRUMENT PANEL COVER REMOVAL



1. From underneath the instrument panel cover, unscrew two (2) socket hex screws.

2. Look at the following image to understand how the instrument panel cover is held in place with flexible tabs close to the windshield.



3. Lift the edge of the instrument panel cover with a light force then pull the cover toward you.





PART 2 - DASHBOARD COVER REMOVAL

1. Remove the three (3) screws shown on the image below.



2. Unsnap the dashboard cover at the five (5) points identified on the image below.






PART 3 - RIGHT SIDE OF THE DASHBOARD – ACCESS PANEL REMOVAL

1. The panel on the right side of the dashboard is secured with fasteners as seen on the images below.






FIGURE 9: ATTACHMENT POINTS AT THE BACK OF THE PANEL






2. To remove the panel, pull (unsnap) the bottom of the panel in three (3) places by pulling toward you and then pull the panel down to disengage the top.







PART 4 - RIGHT SIDE OF DASHBOARD REMOVAL

- 1. Perform Part 1, 2 & 3.
- 2. Remove the three (3) screws shown on the image below.





3. Unsnap the trim at the attachment point identified on the images below.




6. Disconnect the hose shown on the image below.





8. Remove the panel shown on the image below. To do so, perform the following steps.







11. To remove the panel, first, remove the two (2) screws identified on the images below.








FIGURE 25: WITH PANEL GHOSTED TO HELP LOCATE THE POSITION OF THE SCREWS

12. To remove the panel, pull (unsnap) at the six (6) locations identified on the image below.



13. Once unsnap, pull with a light force to detach the panel.

14. Disconnect the register hose and the daylight sensor connector from the R.H. side of the panel.



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
