#### **DESCRIPTION**

On the above mentioned vehicles, it is necessary to protect some connectors in case of water seepage.

#### **PROCEDURE**

**Warning**: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.




FIGURE 1 : MARKER LIGHT

- 1. Locate the two marker lights beside the front electrical compartment. Dismount the lower one (item figure 1).
- 2. Check the water tightness of the cable grommet, apply Sikaflex or a silicone sealant.
- 3. Open the front electrical compartment door. Referring to figure 1, check if there is water in the area behind the marker lights.
- 4. In the same area, connectors (C45, C500, C506, etc.) must be fastened to a nearby wire harness to keep them off the floor and out of humidity (figure 1). Use cable ties.
