#### **PROCEDURE**

**Warning**: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

1. Open the lift mechanism baggage door and swing open until locked open. Pull the wheelchair access door opening handle in the top left corner of the baggage compartment and swing the door until locked open.

A light inside the vehicle illuminates the doorway when the wheelchair access door is open.

Note: Add some gray Sikaflex 221 behind the rivets before securing the support.

- 2. Separate former support from handle and secure new support (287174) using rivets (504379). Do not install handle at this moment.
- 3. From inside of vehicle, remove finishing trim in the vicinity of door lock. Remove top aluminum molding and lateral panel.

4. Remove parts identified in figure 4 then install new mechanism (289242) and new control cable (780636) as indicated in figures 5 and 6. Secure new mechanism using screws (500658) then verify for proper operation. Secure control cable to handle then tighten the nuts as indicated in figure 3.

**Note:** Proper operation may be affected if mechanism nut (see 500590, figure 4) or handle nuts are too tight (see figure 3).

**Note:** Adjust height of mechanism (289242) so that at least ½" of cable travel is necessary before the first release. Cable tension can be adjusted by changing the position of the spring (3 holes).




FIGURE 1: WHEELCHAIR LIFT AND DOORS




FIGURE 2: OPENING MECHANISM





FIGURE 3: HANDLE AND SUPPORT

FIGURE 4: FORMER INSTALLATION




FIGURE 6: DETAILS OF NEW MECHANISM




FIGURE 7: CUTTING LATERAL PANEL

5. Cut interior lateral panel as indicated in figure 7 then reinstall interior finishing trim.
