#### **APPLICATION**

This Safety Recall does not necessarily apply to all the above-mentioned vehicles, some vehicles may have been modified before delivery. The owners of the vehicles affected by this recall will be advised by a letter indicating the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) of each vehicle concerned.

# **DESCRIPTION**

On vehicles affected by this recall, there is a possibility that one front radius rod support, road side, does not meet the specifications.

All suspected vehicles shall have their road side radius rod support inspected, and all parts fabricated under lot #11048 will be replaced, free of charge.


# **PROCEDURE**




# **DANGER**

Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

1. On front I-Beam axle, left hand side (road side). Check casting number in cavity of radius rod support 110739.



2. If casting number in cavity is **11048**, part must be replaced.



- 3. Dismount support and radius rod.
- 4. Discard hardware
- 5. Install replacement part with new bolts, nuts and washers.
- 6. Threads and holes must be clean and dry.
- 7. Tighten to specified torque.
- 8. Apply tectyl compound 680064 on bolt and nut after tightening

  BOLT 5001175 QTY 5
  NUT 5001665 QTY 5
  WASHER 5001509 QTY 5
  TIGHTEN TO 255 LB-FT QTY 5
- 9. Install radius rod on new support.
- 10.Threads and holes must be clean and dry.
- 11. Apply blue Loctite 680038
- 12. Tighten to specified torque.
- 13.Bend lock on bolt head.
- 14. Perform vehicle alignment



# **DISPOSITION OF PARTS**

- Return to Prevost with A.F.A. for full reimbursement.
- Discard according to applicable environmental regulations (Municipal/State[Prov.]/ Federal)

# WARRANTY

This modification is covered by Prevost's normal warranty. We will reimburse you half an hour (0.5h) of labor for inspection only or the parts and two hours (2.0) of labor for inspection, replacement and alignment upon receipt of the replaced parts and a completed A.F.A. form on which you must specify as per "Safety Recall 13-01". You also have to fill the "Safety Recall Certification Sheet" provided with this bulletin and return it with your A.F.A. form to be reimbursed.
