DESCRIPTION:

Due to interference between the HVAC compartment door and the baggage door to its right, a retrofit kit designed to permit opening of the HVAC door from the left baggage compartment is available.

MATERIAL

Part No.	Description	Qty
285848	Condenser door latch retrofit kit.	1


Note: Material can be obtained through regular channels.

PROCEDURE

Warning: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch (es) to the OFF position before working on the vehicle.

- 1. Open A/C condenser door and condenser assembly as per maintenance manual.
- 2. Remove the three screws (A, Fig. 1) holding the door latch assembly. Remove the assembly.
- 3. Remove the door-opening knob and cover the hole with the included plug (1, Fig. 2).
- 4. Open the compartment door to the left of the A/C condenser compartment.
- 5. Drill a 3/8" (9 mm) diameter hole in the right compartment wall, 10-1/2" (265 mm) inside and 3" (75 mm) from the top of the compartment's ceiling. See figure 1.

- 6. Pass the straight end of the pull cable through the hole and attach its sheath to the wall with the appropriate fastener. Screw pull-knob to cable.
- 7. Pass the pull cable and sheath along the ceiling of A/C compartment (over air duct). Attach solidly with the included collars. Drill 5/32" (4 mm) pilot holes and use the #10 self-tapping screws provided to fasten the collars.
- 8. Install the support plate to the support member. Use the existing holes (B, Fig. 2). Fasten using a M6x20 screw (Prévost #502622), M6 lockwasher (#502565) and M6 nut (#502570). Adjust so the cable is properly aligned and will operate the door latch easily.
- 9. Install the included connector plate on the door latch assembly (2, fig. 1 or 2, Fig. 2). Install the offset portion of the pull cable in the hole of the connector plate. Install the cable's sheath extremity tightly into the connector plate's sleeve (3, Fig. 3).
- 10. Screw the latch mechanism loosely. Adjust mechanism as needed. Tighten screws. Check door fit and operation.






