DESCRIPTION

On the above-mentioned vehicles, it is necessary to secure the rear lights' electrical cables to reduce the risk of damage.

MATERIAL

Part No.	Description	Qty
504013	Tie mount	2
504248	Rivet*	2
504637	Cable tie	2

^{*} It is possible to use #500416 screws and #500423 nuts instead of the rivets.

Note: Material can be obtained through regular channels.

PROCEDURE

Warning: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

- 1. Open the rear engine door.
- 2. Locate the metallic plates holding the top part of the door's cylinders. These plates are located in the upper part of the compartment.




Figure 1: Location of the hole to drill.

- 3. Drill a 3/16" (5 mm) hole into the inside part of a metallic plate (figure 1). Fix the tie mount using a rivet or a screw and nut.




Figure 2: Rear lights' cables, on the driver side. (1) Tie mount and cable tie; (2) Cable tie.




Figure 3: Rear lights' cables, on the entrance door side. (1) Tie mount and cable tie.

- 4. Fix the lights' electrical cable to the tie mount, using a cable tie (figure 2, item 1). Leave a 1 3/16 in (30 mm) gap between the head of the bolt holding the cylinder and the cable (figure 3). This will reduce the risk of damage to the electrical cable.
- 5. If needed, fix the cable to the vehicle (figure 2, item 2).
- 6. Repeat steps 1 to 5 for the other metallic plate.
