DESCRIPTION

On the above-mentioned vehicles, it is necessary to install a "STARTER ON" warning light to tell the driver if the starter should happen to stay engaged after the engine starting.

MATERIAL

For modification of a **H3 series** vehicle, 2PCH33419V101<u>1718</u> and from 2PCH3349XV101<u>1779</u> up to 2PCV3349W101<u>2284</u> except 2PCH33494W101<u>2234</u>, order kit #065217 that includes the following parts:

PART A : H3 SERIES VEHICLES ; V1718 AND FROM V1779 UP TO W2284 EXCEPT W2234

PROCEDURE

Warning: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

- 1. Open engine compartment R.H. side door (figure 1).
- 2. Fix 86F end terminal ring of fuse harness (Prévost part 065213) to the Bendix terminal (figure 2). Tighten the nut to a torque of 180 to 240 lb-in.
- 3. Insert a heat shrinking sleeve and crimp 86T end of fuse harness (Prévost part 065213) to wire SP58 from the E.C.M. (electronic control module) harness, heat the sleeve. Read the following note.

Note : Wire SP58 is a spare wire that comes out of the E.C.M. harness plastic corrugated sleeve. E.C.M. harness starts on the lower right side of the E.C.M. and goes along the inclined square tube on the engine right side. For location of wire SP58, see figure 3.



- 4. In the driver's area, remove the dashboard cover.
- 5. Insert wire 86T (Prévost part 065214) to port #12 (coach) or port #2 (VIP bus shell) into connector C516, identified with a tag (figure 4).
- 6. Locate wire SP58 (gray) behind the dashboard.
- 7. Connect wire 86T (Prévost part 065214) to wire SP58.
- 8. Remove the telltale panel fixing screws and pull out the telltale panel.

- 9. Insert the "STARTER ON" telltale light film (Prévost part 563022) into the telltale panel by the opening on the top (figure 4).
- 10. Reinstall the telltale panel and tighten the fixing screws.

- 11. Set battery master switch(es) to the ON position and start the engine. The "STARTER ON" warning light should switch on during the engine starting, then switch off.
- 12. Secure all wires with nylon cable ties and reinstall dashboard cover.
- 13. Close all access doors. The installation is now completed.

PART B : H3 SERIES VEHICLES ; W2234 AND FROM W2285 UP TO Y3395

PROCEDURE

Warning: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

- 1. Open engine compartment R.H. side door (figure 1).
- 2. Fix 86F end terminal ring of fuse harness (Prévost part 065213) to the Bendix terminal (figure 2). Tighten the nut to a torque of 180 to 240 lb-in.
- 3. Insert a heat shrinking sleeve and crimp 86T end of fuse harness (Prévost part 065213) to wire SP58 from the E.C.M. (electronic control module) harness, heat the sleeve. Read the following note.

Note : Wire SP58 is a spare wire that comes out of the E.C.M. harness plastic corrugated sleeve. E.C.M. harness starts on the lower right side of the E.C.M. and goes along the inclined square tube on the engine right side. For location of wire SP58, see figure 3.

- 4. In the driver's area, disconnect the microphone cable and remove the dashboard cover (figure 5).
- 5. Disconnect the microphone connector cable on the internal face of the dashboard cover.
- 6. Insert 86T end (red) of relay harness (Prévost part 065212) to port #10 of connector C571, identified with a tag (figure 6).
- 7. Locate wire SP58 (gray) behind the dashboard (figure 6).
- 8. Connect SP58 end of relay harness (Prévost part 065212) to wire SP58.
- 9. Fit together the relay base and a relay base already in place behind the dashboard. Insert the relay (Prévost part 561707) on the base.

- 10. Route OT1 end of relay harness through the front electric compartment by the access way in the left corner, behind the dashboard.
- 11. In the front electric compartment, fix OT1 ring terminal to a ground stud.
- 12. Remove the telltale panel fixing screws and pull out the telltale panel (figure 6).
- 13. Insert the "STARTER ON" telltale light film (Prévost part 563016) into the telltale panel by the opening on the top (figure 7).
- 14. Reinstall the telltale panel and tighten the fixing screws.
- 15. Set battery master switch(es) to the ON position and start the engine. The "STARTER ON" warning light should switch on during the engine starting, then switch off.



16. Secure all wires with nylon cable ties, reconnect the microphone cables and reinstall the dashboard cover.

17. Close all access doors. The installation is now completed.

PART C : XL SERIES VEHICLES ; FROM T5680 UP TO Y7045

PROCEDURE

Warning: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

- 1. Open engine compartment R.H. side door (figure 8).
- 2. Fix 86F end terminal ring of fuse harness (Prévost part 065213) to the Bendix terminal (figure 2). Tighten the nut to a torque of 180 to 240 lb-in.
- 3. Insert a heat shrinking sleeve and crimp 86T end of fuse harness (Prévost part 065213) to wire SP5 from the E.C.M. (electronic control module) harness, heat the sleeve. Read the following note.

Note : Wire SP5 is a spare wire that comes out of the E.C.M. harness plastic corrugated sleeve. E.C.M. harness starts on the lower right side of the E.C.M. and goes along the inclined square tube on the engine right side. For location of wire SP5, see figure 3.



- 4. Open the front electric compartment door (figure 8).
- 5. Place the "STARTER ON" telltale light film (Prévost part 392131) inside the indicator light casing (Prévost part 562113).

- 6. In the driver's area, insert the indicator light casing in an available space on the telltale panel (figure 9).
- 7. Remove the dashboard panel (figure 9).
- 8. Connect one end of wire OT1 & 86T (Prévost part 065215) to the indicator light casing terminals.
- 9. Route the other end of wire OT1 & 86T through the front electric compartment by the access way in the left corner , behind the dashboard.
- 10. In the front electric compartment, connect wire OT1 ring terminal to stud 89 and connect wire 86T to wire SP5 (figure 10).

- 11. Set battery master switch(es) to the ON position and start the engine. The "STARTER ON" warning light should switch on during the engine starting, then switch off.
- 12. Secure all wires with nylon cable ties and reinstall the dashboard panel.
- 13. Close all access doors. The installation is now completed.
