**DESCRIPTION**

On the vehicles affected by this bulletin the rear junction box decal located in the right engine compartment is displaying incorrect information regarding the R34 relay voltage.

Specifically, the R34 relay should be identified as a 24 volt relay instead of a 12 volt relay.

Consequently, all affected vehicles must have a small decal displaying the correct information applied over the rear junction box decal R34 relay description.

## PROCEDURE



### **DANGER**

Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

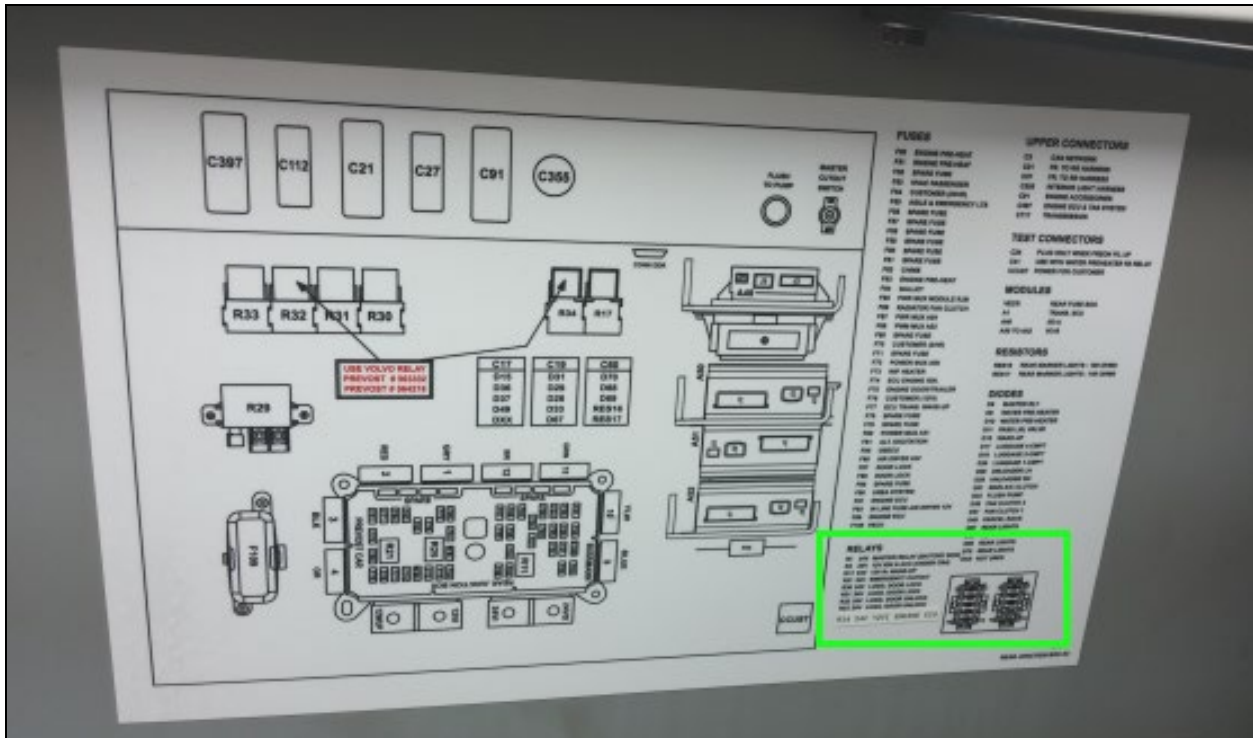


Fig2. Typical relay identification area - Rear Junction Box decal (X3 Coach Shown).

1. Open the vehicle right engine door and locate the rear junction box decal (Fig.1 & 2).

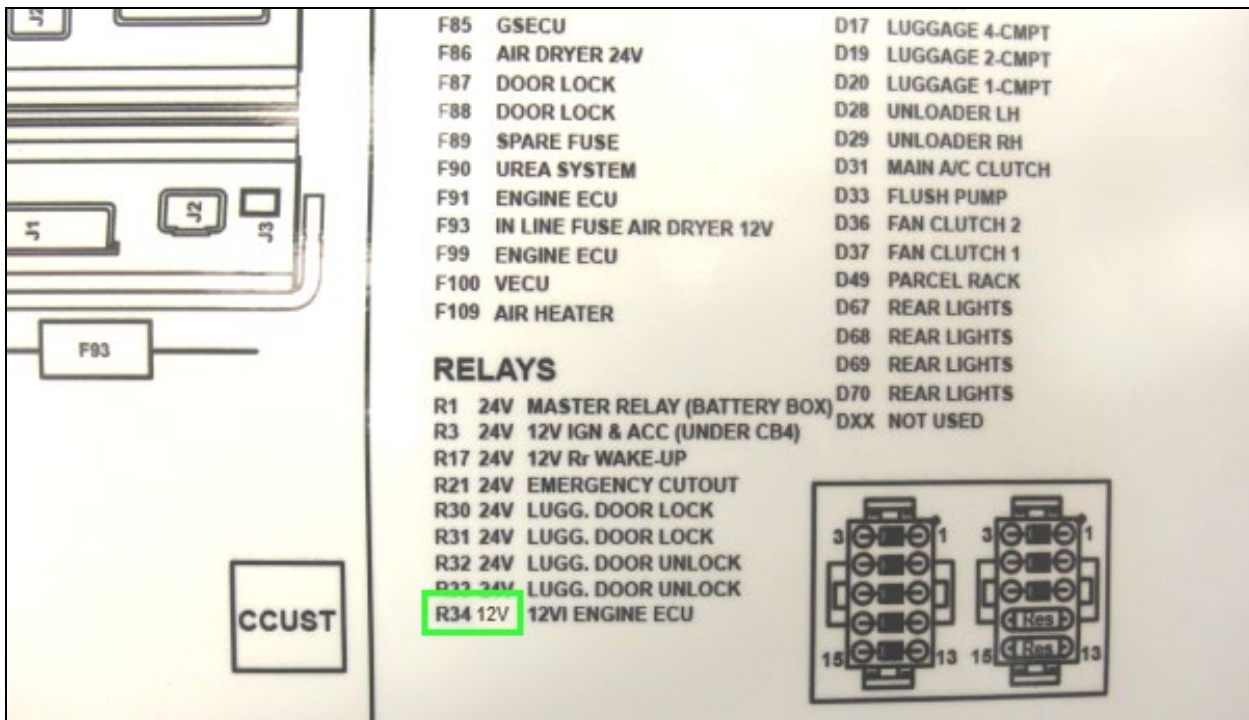


Fig.3 R34 Relay incorrect 12V information (X3-45 Coach Shown).

- On the decal lower right corner, validate that the R34 relay description is inaccurate (Fig.3) and identifies the relay as being a 12 volt relay (12V) instead of a 24 volt (24V).

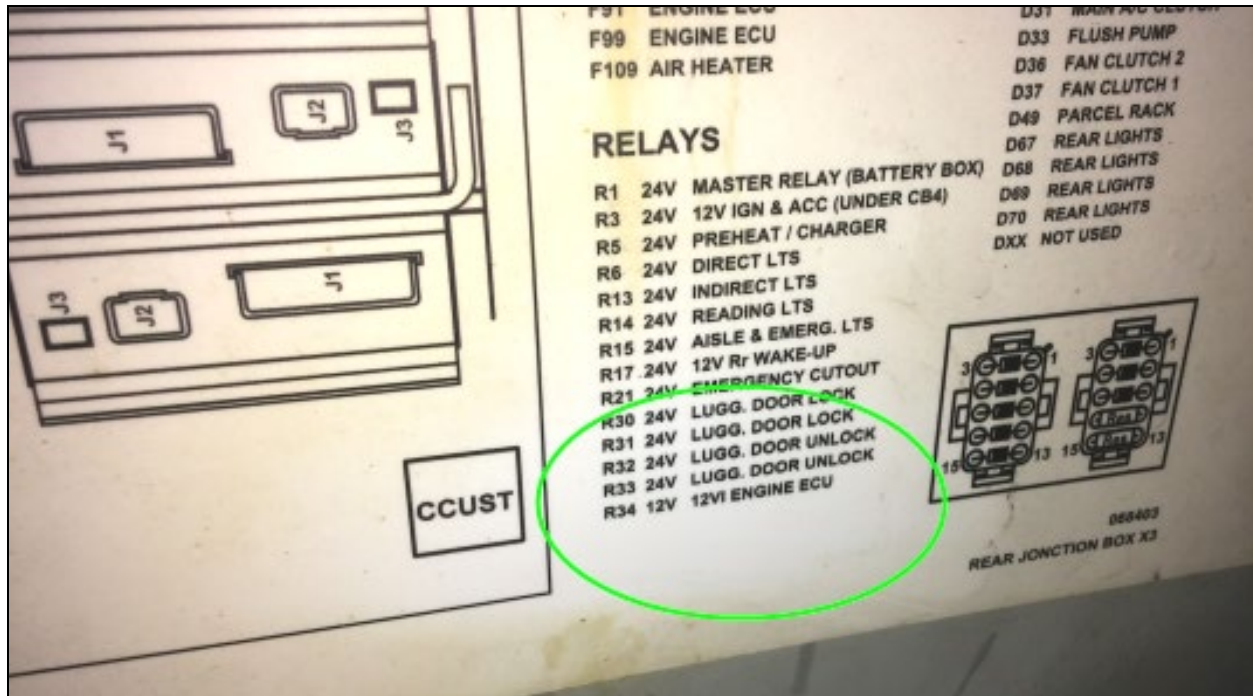


Fig.4 Cleaned area before decal application (Older X3-45 Coach Shown).

3. To ensure proper adhesion of the new decal, carefully clean the area from grease, dirt and road grime (Fig.4).

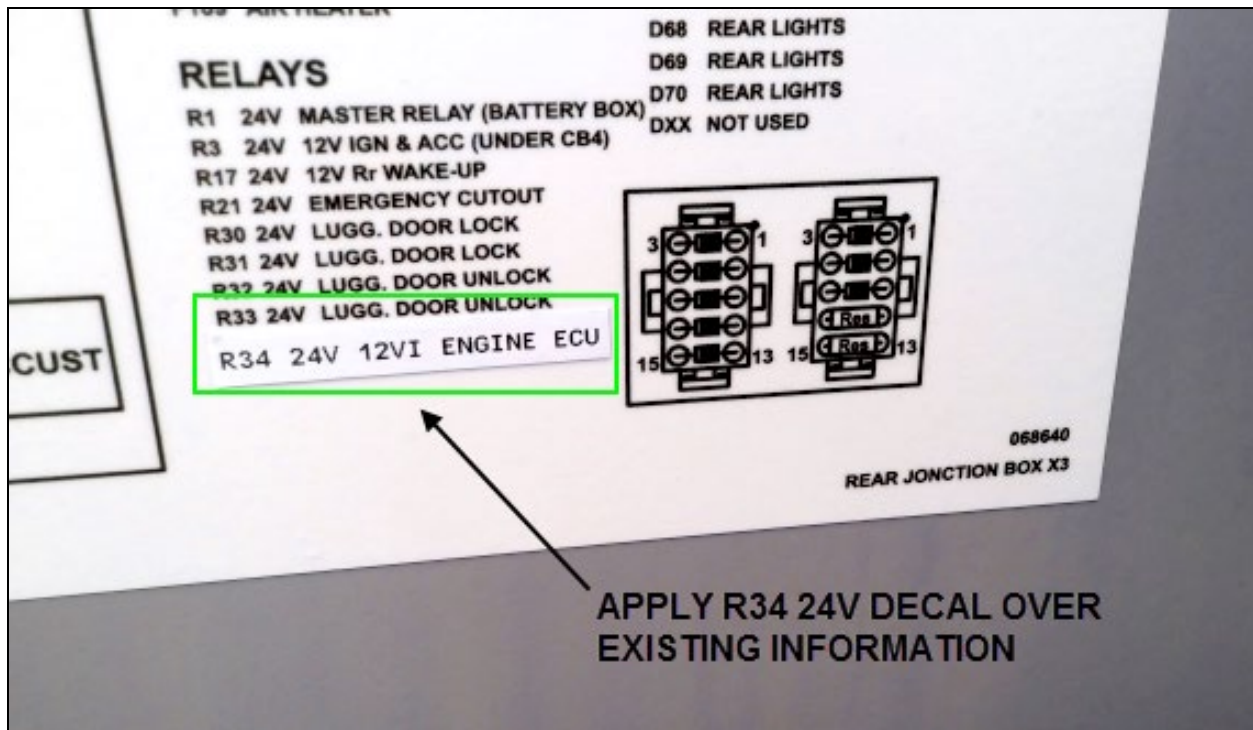


Fig.5 Decal showing correct R34 voltage (X3 Coach Shown).

4. Apply the new decal over the existing 12 volt information as shown on Fig.5 and make sure of proper adhesion (apply pressure on the entire area with a plastic card or scraper. In cold weather, apply moderate heat as necessary).

5. Put the master switch(es) to the ON position to complete the installation.
