# **QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE - VSS-05 SOUND SELECTOR & RADIO**

#### **VSS-05 SOUND SELECTOR**



#### TURNING POWER ON AND OFF

AUDIO

Press 🙂 button to turn on the unit.

Press Ů button again to turn off the unit.

#### SETTING OF VOLUME/ BASS/ TREBLE/ BALANCE/ LOUDNESS

Press AUDIO button repeatedly to choose the desired mode. Each press changes the modes as follows:

 $\rightarrow$  VOL  $\rightarrow$  BASS  $\rightarrow$  TREB  $\rightarrow$  BAL  $\rightarrow$  LOUD

Turn volume knob until the desired sound is obtained in each mode. The final setting will apply to all audio sources for the passenger's area. If no button is pressed within 8 seconds after selecting BASS, TREB, BAL and LOUD modes, the unit automatically sets in the VOL mode. The volume value adjust from 0 (complete mute) to 40 (maximum).

#### SELECTION OF AUDIO OR AUDIO/VIDEO SOURCE

Press RADIO/CD button to select the dashboard radio as RADIO/CD current audio source for the passenger's area. Pressing this button will also permit to listen to the CD inserted in the dashboard radio. Press AUDIO IN button to select an auxiliary audio input as AUDIO IN current audio source. Press DVD button to select DVD Player as current DVD audio/video source. If an optional TV tuner is installed, press TV button to select it TV as current audio/video source. Press VIDEO IN button to select an auxiliary video input as VIDEO IN current audio/video source.

#### NOTE

CAM

NAV

If CAM or NAV is already activated, DVD, TV or VIDEO IN cannot be selected and displayed.

#### **OPERATION OF THE PANORAMIC VIEW CAMERA**

- Press CAM button to select the optional panoramic view camera signal. The VIDEO section of the VSS-05 LCD panel will show "CAM". The video monitors turn on automatically.
  - 2. Press CAM button again to turn off the panoramic view camera and return to previous audio/video source.

#### DISPLAY OF THE GPS NAVIGATION GUIDANCE SCREEN

- Press NAV button to display the optional GPS navigation system guidance screen. The VIDEO section of the VSS-05 LCD panel will show "NAV". The video monitors turn on automatically.
  - Press NAV button again to stop the display of the GPS guidance screen and return to previous audio/video source.

#### **OPERATION OF THE DRIVER MICROPHONE**

- Press D-MIC button to turn on the driver microphone. The LCD panel will show "D-MIC" and a gong sound can be heard.
  - 2. Turn volume knob to adjust microphone level.
  - 3. Press D-MIC button again to turn off the driver microphone.

#### **OPERATION OF THE GUIDE MICROPHONE**

- G-MIC 1. Press G-MIC button to turn on the guide microphone. The LCD panel will show "G-MIC" and a gong sound can be heard.
  - 2. Turn volume knob to adjust microphone level.
  - 3. Press G-MIC button again to turn off the guide microphone.

#### NOTE

D-MIC

The driver and guide microphones can be turned on only by turning the switch on the microphone to ON.

If both the driver and guide microphone are activated, the driver microphone has priority and the guide microphone is muted.

#### BACKGROUND VOLUME ADJUSTMENT

When a microphone is activated, the current audio source volume will reduce to a certain level which as been set at the factory. To adjust this level, proceed as follows:

- 1- Press and hold AUDIO button then press AUDIO IN button. The LCD panel will show "BACK GROUND".
- 2- Turn the volume knob to adjust the background level.
- 3- Press any button to save the setting. If no button is pressed within 8 seconds, the unit automatically saves the setting and exits this mode.

#### GONG SOUND LEVEL

A gong will sound in the passenger's area upon activating of the microphone. This gong will also sound when a passenger activates the service bell. The gong sound level can be adjusted as follows:

- 1- Press and hold AUDIO button then press VIDEO IN button. The LCD panel will show "GONG PASS".
- 2- Turn the volume knob to adjust the gong level.
- 3- Press any button to save the setting. If no button is pressed within 8 seconds, the unit automatically saves the setting and exits this mode.

#### NOTE

While maintaining the service bell gong active, the gong sound heard upon activation of the microphones can be disabled. To do so,

- 1- Press and hold AUDIO button then press G-MIC button. The LCD panel will show "GONG MIC ON" or "GONG MIC OFF".
- 2- Turn the volume knob clockwise to activate the microphones gong sound. Turn the volume knob counterclockwise to deactivate the microphones gong sound.

# CLOCK

#### Setting clock to show time when radio is ON

- 1. Press MENU button.
- 2. Press UP or DOWN buttons until "CLOCK" is displayed.
- 3. Press OK button to enter the clock submenu.
- 4. Press UP or DOWN buttons until "VISIBLE" is displayed.
- 5. Press OK button to change between ON/OFF status.

#### Select a 12 or 24-hour format

- 1. Press MENU button.
- 2. Press UP or DOWN buttons until "CLOCK" is displayed.
- 3. Press OK button to enter the clock submenu.
- 4. Press UP or DOWN buttons until "12/24 HR" is displayed.
- 5. Press OK button to change between 12H or 24H options.

#### Setting time of day

- 1. Press MENU button.
- 2. Press UP or DOWN buttons until "CLOCK" is displayed.
- 3. Press OK button to enter the clock submenu.
- 4. Press UP or DOWN buttons until "SET TIME" is displayed.
- 5. Press OK button to enter the set time submenu.
- 6. Press UP or DOWN buttons to adjust the hours up or down.
- 7. Press OK button to set the hour and toggle to minute adjustment.
- 8. Press UP or DOWN buttons to adjust the minutes up or down.
- 9. Press OK button to save the time and finish the process.

# AUDIO CONTROLS

#### Volume

Turn the rotary knob to adjust the volume.

## Adjusting Balance Left and Right

- 1. Press AUDIO repeatedly until "BALANCE" shows on the display.
- 2. Adjust balance by turning the rotary knob.

## Adjusting Fader Front and Back

- 1. Press AUDIO repeatedly until "FADER" shows on the display.
- 2. Adjust fader by turning the rotary knob.

## Adjusting Treble and Bass

- 1. Press AUDIO repeatedly until "TREBLE" or "BASS" shows on the display.
- 2. Adjust treble or bass by turning the rotary knob.

# Activate Speed Dependant Volume (ASC) - (optional feature)

- 1. Press MENU button.
- 2. Press UP or DOWN buttons until "ADVANCED" is displayed.
- 3. Press OK button to enter the ADVANCED submenu.
- 4. Press UP or DOWN buttons until "ASC" is displayed.
- 5. Press OK button to enter the ASC submenu.
- 6. Press UP or DOWN buttons to choose between LOW, MID and HIGH.
- 7. Press OK button to enter the desired ASC setting.

# **TUNING THE RADIO**

## Band select

To select the radio as the play mode, turn the radio on and press RADIO button.

Press RADIO button repeatedly to switch between bands (AM, FM1, FM2).

#### Seek

Press the seek buttons ESC or OK to seek up or down to the next lower or higher station.

#### Manual Tuning

Press UP or DOWN buttons to tune up or down on the radio.

#### Scan Mode

- 1. Press MENU button.
- 2. Select "SCAN" by pushing OK button.
- 3. To exit the scan mode and stay at the present station, press RADIO button.

### PRESETS (12 FM & 6 AM preset channels)

#### Storing preset radio stations

- 1. Press RADIO button until the required frequency band is active (AM, FM1, FM2, FM3, Weather, or Satellite radio.
- 2. Tune the radio to the desired station.
- 3. Push and hold the desired preset button 1 thru 6.
- 4. There will be a short as the station is stored. When the sound returns, the process is completed.

#### Accessing the preset stations

- 1. Press RADIO button to select the required band
- 2. Press and release the required preset button 1 thru 6.

# CD PLAYER

#### Switching to CD Mode

Press CD/AUX button until "CD" shows on the display or insert a CD into the CD slot and it will automatically begin to play.

#### Next/previous track on a CD

Press and release ESC or OK button to move to the next or previous track respectively.
