PROCEDURE



DANGER

Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop the engine. Prior to working on the vehicle, set the ignition switch to the OFF position and trip the main circuit breakers equipped with a trip button.

- 1. Park vehicle on level ground.
- 2. Remove the existing screws and the existing cup behind the door.



3. Remove the handle.

NOTE

Take care not to damage the paint.



- 4. Remove the remaining sealant inside the door.
- 5. If necessary, use an abrasive disc to remove the sealant.



- 6. Polish the contact surfaces with an abrasive disc.
- 7. Wash the surfaces that will be glued with a wipe and anti-silicone before gluing.

8. Apply glue to the three mating surfaces of the handle support and install the handle bracket on the door frame.

NOTE

Make sure the support is horizontally centered with the opening and width. The upper mounting surface of the support should be glued to the metal door crossbar.






9. Install the rubber gasket on the edge of the handle.

CAUTION

Make sure not to use glue, which could damage paint during handle removal if ever the handle needs to be replaced.





10. Install the handle on the door.

NOTE

Make sure the bracket holes and handle holes are aligned.




11. Use a small bubble level and make the handle at level.





12. Install the screws and lock washers.


