

#### DESCRIPTION

Prevost has noticed a quality issue on products made by its headlight supplier. Defective headlights get misted-up and water droplets form inside the housing and on the inner side of the lens. After a product improvement process, this issue has been corrected by the supplier.

Prevost has determined that the vehicles listed above were delivered before the improved headlights were available. We encourage you to replace the headlights on your above listed vehicles as soon as possible.

Prevost will pay for the replacement of headlights of the same type as those installed on the vehicle at time of delivery, as stated on the following table. You can upgrade from halogen headlight to xenon headlight, but you will meet the difference in cost.

Take note that you must absolutely return the replaced headlights for full reimbursement.

#### PROCEDURE



# DANGER


Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.




## WARNING

- To prevent burning yourself, do not replace the light bulbs while they are hot.
- Headlight bulbs have pressurized gas inside and require special handling. They can burst or shatter if scratched or dropped. Hold a bulb only by its plastic case. Do not touch the glass part of a bulb with bare hands.
- 1. Make sure the ignition switch and light switch are off.
- 2. Open the front reclining bumper.
- 3. Pull on the rod indicated by the black arrow to rock the headlight housing.

- 4. Remove 5 indicated nuts (white arrows) and disconnect the electrical harness. Do not loosen any other piece of hardware as you could lose the original headlight adjustment.
- 5. Remove the headlight housing.
- 6. Install the new headlight housing. To do so, repeat the previous steps in reverse order.
- 7. The headlight position in relation to the support doesn't need to be readjusted.
- 8. Headlight aiming is adjusted at time of manufacturing and doesn't need to be readjusted. However, should an adjustment be necessary, the vertical aiming is provided by one adjusting screw (indicated by white arrow) that pivots both high and low beams simultaneously.





#### WARRANTY

This modification is covered by Prevost's normal warranty. We will reimburse you the parts and one hour (1.0) of labor upon receipt of the replaced parts and a completed A.F.A. form on which you must specify as per "Warranty Bulletin 09-12".

#### Parts / Waste disposal:

Return replaced parts to Prevost with A.F.A. for full reimbursement.
