PROCEDURE




DANGER


Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine. Prior to working on the vehicle, set the ignition switch to the OFF position and trip the main circuit breakers equipped with a trip button. On the Commuter type vehicles, set the battery master switch (master cut-out) to the OFF position.

Lock out & Tag out (LOTO) must be performed during set-up, maintenance or repair activities. Refer to your local procedure for detailed information regarding the control of hazardous energy.

- 1. Locate the AE57 module in the luggage compartment (above WCL cassette).
- 2. Locate wires Sw31.A and Se56.A coming out of the module.
- 3. Cut both wires and splice the ends (all four wire ends).
- Joint (solder) the four spliced ends together using a 562228 butt splice (cover the connection with a length of 562499 shrink tubing).
- 5. Power the vehicle electrical circuit and check for proper operation.
