PROCEDURE



DANGER

Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop the engine. Prior to working on the vehicle, set the ignition switch to the OFF position and trip the main circuit breakers equipped with a trip button. On the Commuter type vehicles, set the battery master switch (master cut-out) to the OFF position.

Lockout & Tag out (LOTO) must be performed during set-up, maintenance or repair activities. Refer to your local procedure for detailed information regarding the control of hazardous energy.

SOFTWARE VERSION VERIFICATION

1. Access to the driver information display with the right steering wheel switches.

DID Menu Navigation

(A) Scroll up (scroll wheel rocker type).

(B) Scroll down (scroll wheel rocker type).

(C) Enter / Select (scroll wheel rocker type with push functionality).

A, B & C: Toggle/Scroll Up/Down/Enter Button; Used to open, scroll through menus, adjust values or make selections.

(D) Application tray / Back button.

Opens the Applications menu.

Returns to the previous view.

(E) Home screen.

Returns to the home screen and when pressed a second time, returns to the starting view.

(F) Options tray
