PROCEDURE

Warning: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

- 1. Remove the drive motors protective cover. Disconnect the power supply cables connected to the drive motor screw terminals.
- 2. Dismount the drive motors and separate the fan from the shaft. Keep the hardware for later use.




FIGURE 1: H3 SERIES, UP TO V-1961




FIGURE 2: H3 SERIES, FROM V-1961

- 3. Fix the fans onto the shafts and install the new drive motors as per figure 1, 2 or 3 depending on the type of vehicle. Use the included shims to center the fan in the circular opening.

Note: On H5-60 series vehicles, the shims might not be necessary.

4. Reconnect the power supply cables as described in figure 4 or 5 depending on the type of vehicle. Apply a coat of rubber protector Color Guard (Prevost #684013) on the terminals to protect against corrosion.

Note: The negative screw terminal (-) is on the shaft side and the positive screw terminal is the one in the middle (see figure 4).

- 5. Fix the protective covers to #453687 shims where applicable. If needed, place a flat washer between the cover and the support.
- 6. Test the functioning of the system.




FIGURE 3: XL, XLII




FIGURE 4: CONNECTIONS




FIGURE 5: CONNECTIONS
