DESCRIPTION

On the above-mentioned vehicles, a problem may affect intermittent mode on upper windshields wipers. This problem is caused by a poor ground. If you have experienced this problem on your vehicle, we recommend you to correct it as per the following procedure.


MATERIAL

Part No	Description	Qty
-----	Wire assembly (included with this warranty bulletin)	1

PROCEDURE

Warning: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

1. In front service compartment, open alarm junction box.
2. Remove the bus bars on studs #1 and #2 (Fig.1).



3. Connect wires *LLO* and *OA* with wire *OP* on stud #1 (Fig. 2). Remove wire *SP39* from stud #5 and connect it on stud #2 with wire *OB*.



Note: Wires are identified by their number.

4. In front electric compartment, open front junction box.
5. Install a jumper between stud #8 and stud A (Fig. 3).


