DESCRIPTION

On the vehicles subjected to this maintenance information, the latch assembly on the luggage doors may be replaced by an improved version.

MATERIAL

H3-45 Coach: order MI16-31-1, one per vertically opening pantograph baggage door:

PROCEDURE



DANGER

Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine. Prior to working on the vehicle, set the ignition switch to the OFF position and trip the main circuit breakers equipped with a trip button. On Commuter type vehicles, set the battery master switch (master cut-out) to the OFF position.

1. On the vehicles, locate the luggage doors. Open each door and find the lock assembly with micro switch. (Figure 1)

2. Visually confirm if the guard washer is added or not to the micro switch. (Figure 2)

If washer is installed, end of procedure.

If washer is not installed, proceed to next step.






Figure 3: Control rod clip

- 3. Prepare latch for disassembly. (Figure 3)
 - A Unplug the connector
 - **B** Cut the cable ties, cable routing may differ
 - C Release clip from control rod.

Release clip by rotating it away from rod. (Figure 2)

Then pull control rod out of clip. Remove clip from latch lever. Discard clip.



- 4. Remove the latch assembly (Two screws). Keep hardware for re-use. (Figure 4)
- 5. Install the new latch.
 - Tighten screws to 7 lb-ft.
- 6. Plug connector to door harness (A, Figure 3)
- 7. Secure cable with new cable ties. (B, Figure 3)
- 8. Install clip 780340 (Figure 2) on latch lever. Slide rod in clip. Rotate clip on rod.
- 9. Make sure door operates properly.
