## PROCEDURE



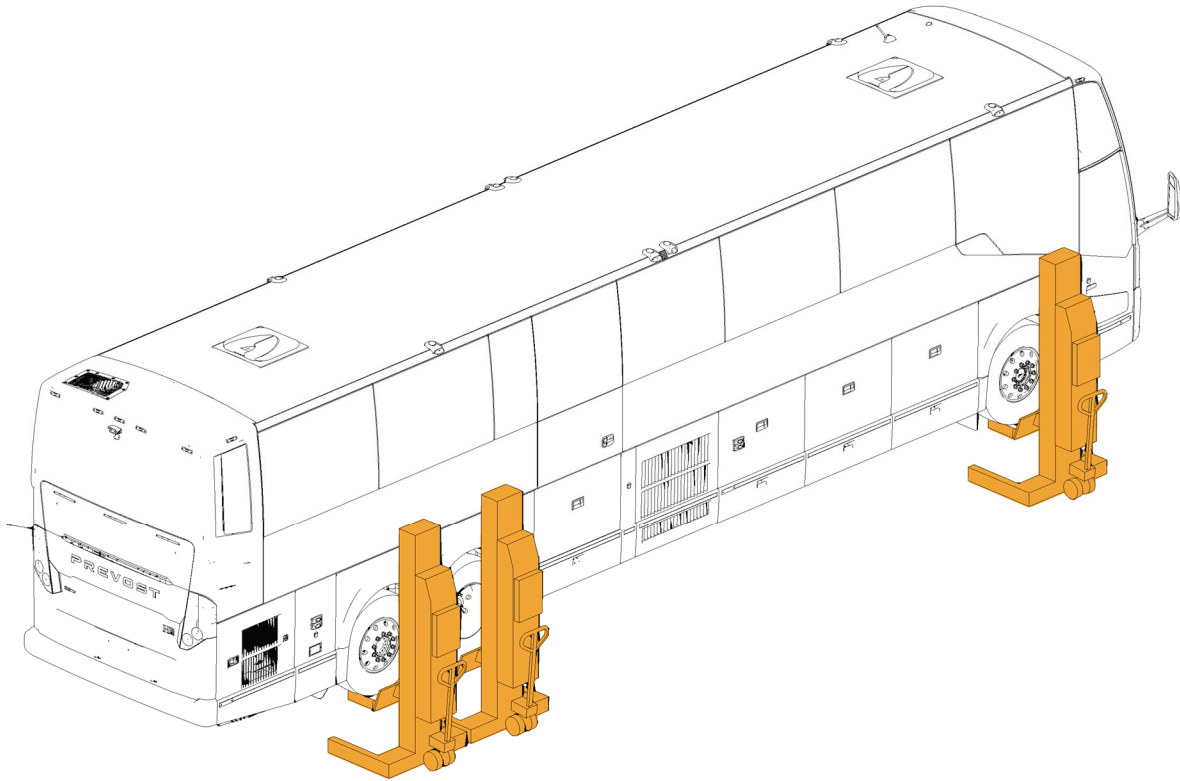
### DANGER

Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine. Prior to working on the vehicle, set the ignition switch to the OFF position and trip the main circuit breakers equipped with a trip button. On Commuter type vehicles, set the battery master switch (master cut-out) to the OFF position.

Lock out & Tag out (LOTO) must be performed during set-up, maintenance or repair activities. Refer to your local procedure for detailed information regarding the control of hazardous energy.

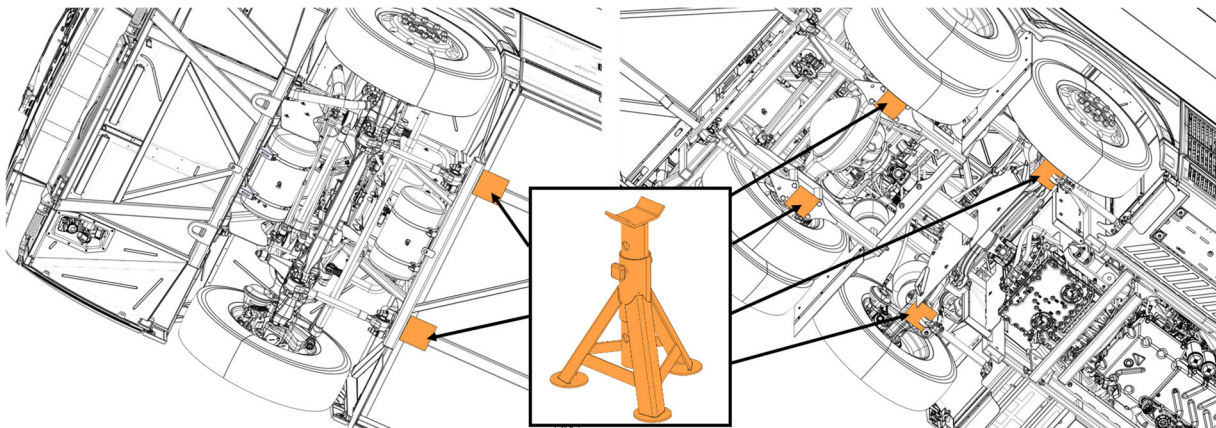
## VEHICLE LIFTING

1. Insert the lifting equipment(6x). Note: the tag axle must be lifted too to prevent overloading the drive axle tires.
2. When the lifting equipment has been inserted under the wheels, it is recommended to releasing the parking brake to allow the wheels to turn freely during the lift, to avoid stressing the wheel seals on the drive axle.
3. Lift the vehicle.



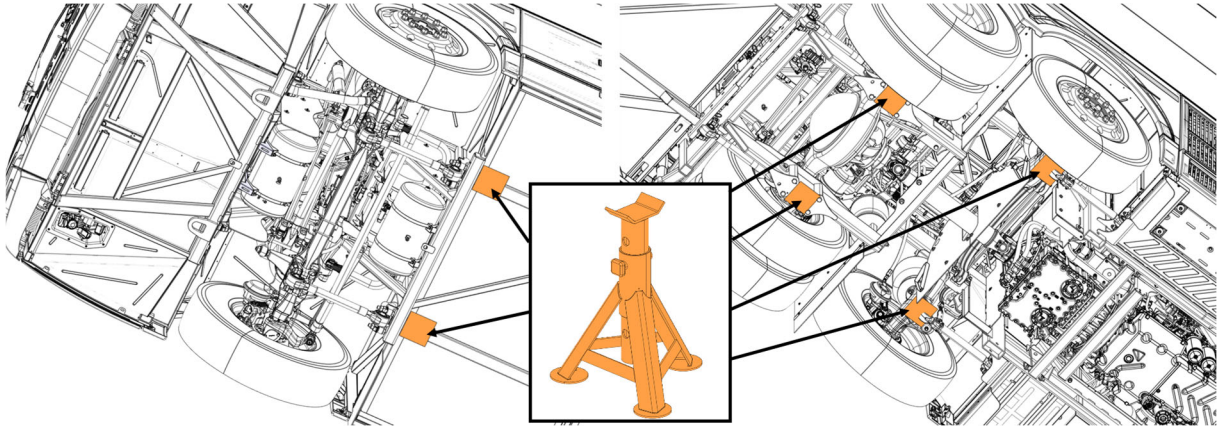
4. Secure the vehicle with six(6x) jack stands.

Refer to maintenance information MI18-18 for the jack stand capacity and location on the vehicle.

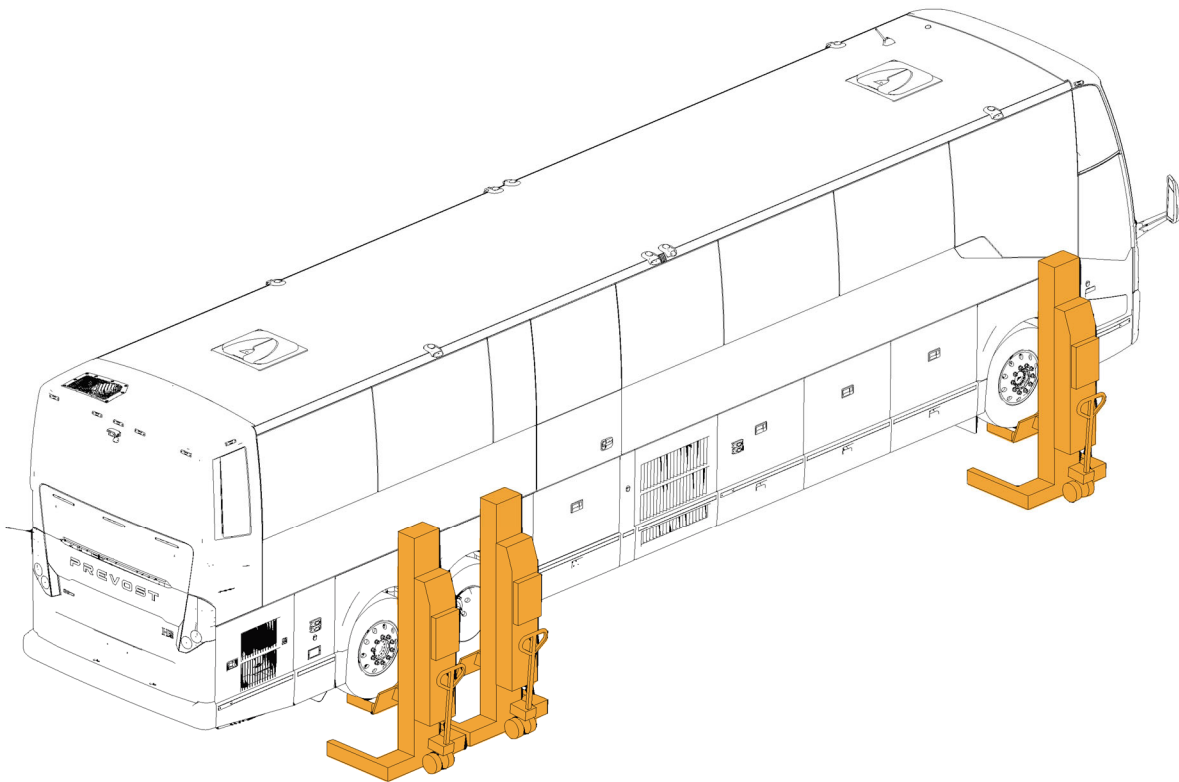


## LOWER THE VEHICLE

1. Remove the six(6X) jack stands.



2. Lower the vehicle.
3. Apply parking brake.
4. Remove the lifting equipment(6x).
