DESCRIPTION

On the vehicles affected by this bulletin, perform a power source improvement and a multiplex software update for the steering Gateway module. On a limited number of vehicles, the module will be replaced with the latest version of the part.

PROCEDURE



DANGER

Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

STEP A:

- A. GATEWAY MODULE INSPECTION AND REPLACEMENT
- A1. Remove the dashboard cover (5 screws).

- A2. Locate gateway module. It is installed flat, behind the left portion of the dashboard.
- A3. Check module revision label. (Fig 4) If it is **SM320 REV:A SW REV:1.00** and up, jump to **STEP B** below.



- A4. Unscrew module (2 screws). Disconnect cable.
- A5. Keep old module for parts return.
- A6. Replace by a new module **565921**. New module must be revision SM320 REV:A SW REV:1.00 and up.

STEP B:

- B. POWER CABLE CHANGE
- B1. Unplug Connector to Gateway module A139.
- B2. Locate wire **439** at **pin 1** of Gateway Module A139. (Fig 5)
- B3. Cut about <u>two inches away</u> (50mm) from connector. (Fig 5)

Protect and seal bare wire end coming from dash with shrink tubing.



B4. Run a new yellow 16ga **GXL** wire (560661 or equiv.) from A44 module in Front Junction Box to Gateway module.

Strip and connect to wire 439 coming out of gateway module connector pin 1 and new wire from front service compartment (FJB).

Use thermal shrink butt splice 563623. (Fig 6)



B5. Connect new wire to **A44:J1** using terminal 563692. (Fig 7)

Pin: 5 for H3-45 **VIP and** X3-45 **VIP. Pin: 6** for H3 **BUS** and X3-45 **BUS**

B6. Next, proceed to multiplex reprogramming, "Complist 2014".

X3BUS - 06100058 P21 and up

H3BUS-06100060 P26 and up

VIP/Motorhomes - 06100061 P25 and up

- B7. Check proper operation of all controls on the steering wheel:
 - Cruise
 - Motorized Blinds
 - Radio controls
 - Etc.


