DESCRIPTION

On the above-mentioned vehicles, a female connector assembly C139J (presently not connected) is provided. In the event that the A/C module becomes defective and causes the interruption of the air conditioning system, disconnecting the male connector C139 from A/C module and reconnecting to female connector C139J will allow the by-pass of A/C module. The A/C system will be able to run but however without regulation. The purpose of the present bulletin is the replacement of connector assembly C139J with a new connector assembly which will allow the condenser fans to run normally in addition to obtain air conditioning in driver's compartment.

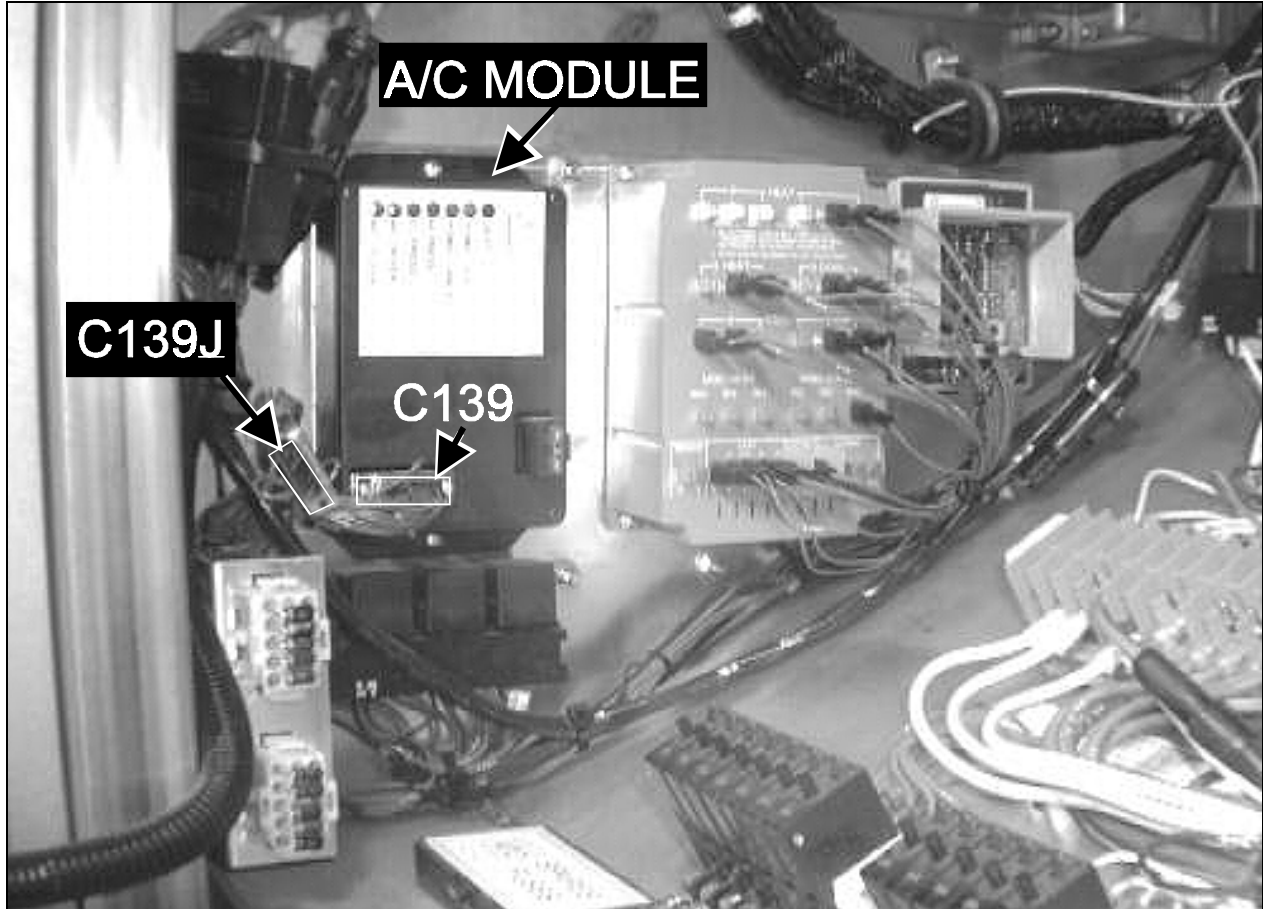
PROCEDURE

Warning: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

1. Open L.H. rear electric compartment door.
2. Locate on the L.H. wall, the connector C139 connected to A/C module (refer to figure), trace wiring harness of this connector up to the identification of connector assembly C139J. Remove cable tie retaining connector assembly C139J to wiring harness. Discard connector assembly then using a cable tie, fasten in its place the new connector assembly C139J (#064548).

Note: Connecting connector assembly C139J will be necessary only if you wish to by-pass the A/C module.

3. Close L.H. rear electric compartment door.
