# DESCRIPTION

On the above-mentioned coaches, two protective panels designed to prevent ice build-up on the height control valve may be missing. Follow the instructions below to install the panels.

#### MATERIAL

502810	Screw, self tapping, hexagonal washerhead, M6 .3 x 30	4

**Note** : Material can be obtained through regular channels.

# PROCEDURE

**Warning**: Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

1. Lift the coach or drive over a repair pit;

- 2. Find the height control valve for the front suspension;




FIGURE 1: POTECTIVE PANNEL INSTALLED (SAME ON BOTH SIDES)

- 3. Install the panels (one per side) and secure using the screws included (refer to figure 1).
